4 Steps 2 Change Everything

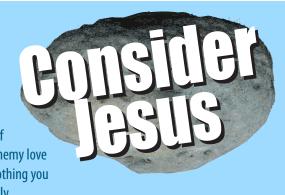
Step 1: Just consider Jesus. That seems too simple. Don't I have to believe or follow Jesus? Trust me for a minute and just start by considering Him.

Step 3: Journey Spiritually. How? Getting spiritual might be too much for me. This isn't complicated. If you are talking you are already halfway there. Spirituality is like yeast, just start with a little and it will grow all on its own. Simply prepare mentally for change, ask God to help you be willing to change, make amends with those you've wronged, wash and repeat.



Everyone is on a spiritual journey, the question is are you asking for help from God through prayer and meditation.

Step 4: Be a priest. This is getting weird...

Wait! It really isn't weird... a priest is just a regular person who helps other regular people consider Jesus, talk, and walk their spiritual journey. A priest is like a guide.
